Using alternate lines, translate the following passage into English:

A Sheepish Mistake

ἀγαθὸς αὐτουργὸς καλεῖ τοὺς ἑταίρους ἀπὸ τῆς ἑορτῆς εἰς τὴν οἰκίαν καὶ οὕτως λέγει αὐτοῖς· “ὦ φίλοι ἑταῖροι, ἐν νῶ ἔχω λέγειν ὑμῖν καλὸν μῦθον. καιρὸς γὰρ ἔστιν ἀκούειν αὐτόν.

λύκοι μὲν οὖν ὀρώσι πρόβατα ἐν κλήρῳ καὶ κλέπτειν ἐθέλουσι, κύνες δ' φύλαπτουσιν. οἱ οὖν λύκοι τοῖς προβάτοις λέγουσιν· “χαίρετε, ὦ πρόβατα. μὴ φοβεῖσθε. εἰρήνην γὰρ βουλόμεθα. τοῖς μὲν γε προβάτοις οὐκ ἔσμεν ἐχθροί, τοῖς δὲ κυσίν. ἐπεὶ τοὺς κύνας τοὺς ἀγρίους ἀποπέμπετε, φίλοι τοῖς μήλοισ ἐσμέν. τὰ δὲ πρόβατα τοῖς τῶν λύκων λόγοις πείθεται καὶ δι' ὀλίγου ἀποπέμπει τοὺς κύνας. καὶ ἐνταῦθα δὴ οἱ λύκοι τρέχουσιν εἰς τὸν κλήρον καὶ ἀποκτείνουσι τὰ πρόβατα.” ”

οἱ δ' ἑταῖροι πολὺν χρόνον θαυμάζουσι τὸν τοῦ αὐτουργοῦ μῦθον καὶ βούλονται γινώσκειν διὰ τί ὁ αὐτουργὸς λέγει αὐτόν αὐτοῖς. ὁ δὲ αὐτουργός, “ῥάδιόν ἐστι”, φησίν, “ὦ ἑταῖροι. μὴ ἀποπέμπετε τοὺς φίλους διὰ τοὺς τῶν πολεμίων λόγους.”
