What Next

Create Score Profile: For effective tracking of your child's progress it is important to build up a score profile for each question type. It's important to have a few goes at each question type to bring up a clear picture.

Identify Week Areas: Score profile will help in identifying the questions the child is struggling with and the ones he/she is excellent at.

Target practice: Once week areas are identified, it is important to target practice on those specific question types rather than giving child the full length papers. Full length papers should be used for assessment.

Avoid Child Fatigue: Most parents make the mistake of giving their child paper after paper to solve. This causes boredom and fatigue. Mostly it's just a few types of questions that a child struggles at and needs targeted practice for those.
