# **Religious Studies**

### **SECTION 1: Philosophy & Ethics**

- 1. 'It is more probable that God exists than that he does not.' Discuss.
- 2. 'I can never know with certainty that the external world exists.' Discuss.
- 3. 'To be morally good, I must follow a set of rules, not my conscience.' Discuss.
- 4. 'Violent action is the only way to overcome prejudice and discrimination.' Discuss.
- 5. 'I should be free to treat the environment as I choose.' Discuss.

### **SECTION 2: Biblical Texts**

- 1. What do the miracles <u>you have studied</u> tell us about God and Jesus?
- 2. What do the parables <u>you have studied</u> tell us about Jesus' message?
- 3. What do the Old Testament texts <u>you have studied</u> tell us about the nature of human beings?
- 4. What are the main themes of the stories <u>you have studied</u> in the Book of Exodus?
- 5. What do the Crucifixion and Resurrection tell us about the person of Jesus?

# **SECTION 3: Beliefs and Practices**

[You may refer to any of the world's 6 major religions in your answer.]

- 1. To what extent are places of worship essential to religious believers?
- 2. 'Rites of passage are designed for the benefit of human beings, and have nothing to do with God.' Discuss.
- 3. 'Religious festivals are entertainment for the masses, not about man's relationship with God.' Discuss.
- 4. To what extent can someone who says only private prayer as a form of worship be described as a member of a religion?
- 5. To what extent is the strength of someone's faith best expressed by their ability to undertake acts of pilgrimage?
